- Hold tutoring sessions outside of regular class, as needed. Depending on student demand, these could be small group tutoring sessions. All sessions must happen on SRJC campuses, and when possible, these sessions will be scheduled in the MESA Center.
- Meet with the instructor as needed to plan and prepare.
- PALS are hired at STNC; PALS positions are finalized by a faculty member who will serve as the PALS supervisor.
- PALS are expected to participate in up to 5 hours of paid training each semester; PALS attend a Kick-off orientation at the start of the fall semester.
