Morning Sessions

The morning lectures attendees were widely diverse. There were deans, numerous faculty members, managers, and staff. They all seemed to be learning from Dr. Garcia, and many people asked questions at the end of the presentation.

About 10-12 different disciplines were represented, ranging from social sciences to mathematics.

Afternoon workshops

Faculty, managers, and staff were assigned to work in small groups and we were giving specific tasks pertinent to SRJC. At the end of the small group discussion people presented the results of their discussions.
