SRJC Health Sciences department and the HSI STEM Avanzando Initiative presents the 2024 Summer Health Careers Institute (SHCI). SHCI (HLC120) is a 3-unit credit based course for high school students interested in exploring careers in Healthcare. SHCI is intended for students entering their senior year of high school and recent high school graduates who will be entering their first year of college. In this course, students will be introduced to opportunities in healthcare careers through lecture, laboratory, and experiences in clinical settings. Careers include, but are not limited to: Nursing, Nursing Assistant, Nutrition, Dental Hygiene, Dental Assisting, Medical Assisting, Pharmacy Technician, and Radiologic Technology. Students will complete various certification trainings and learn about healthcare job trends, education, and licensure requirements.

*talk to your high school counselor for specific credits earned
- Field trips to long-term and acute care facilities
- Receive CPR, QPR, and First Aid certifications
- Learn: to take vitals, infection control, basic medical terminology, and interpersonal skills needed in healthcare
- Meet and connect with healthcare professionals
- Learn more about personal values, interests to help guide decisions on career goals and pathways
- Create a resume, cover letter, career plan as a part of the portfolio culminating project
